



## DONALD H. LANDER SCHOLARSHIP

*The Donald H. Lander Scholarship was established in 1993 in honour of the Chairman of Canada Post Corporation on the occasion of his appointment to the Order of Canada. This scholarship is an undergraduate scholarship for students entering third year of a business program and is administered by the Community Foundation of Ottawa. A committee established by Canada Post Corporation makes the selection.*

- One scholarship per year will be awarded for a student entering the third year of a program leading to a degree in business administration or management studies
- The scholarship is valued at \$1,000 and is not renewable. It is paid in September of the year in which it is awarded
- Candidates must be Canadian citizens or landed immigrants
- Candidates will have achieved a high level of academic excellence (“A” average)
- Candidates must have a demonstrated interest and involvement in international management studies (This may include participation in an organization such as AIESEC.)
- The applicant may hold concurrently any other awards
- A complete and official transcript is required for each year of your university record, as well as a letter of reference from a professor
